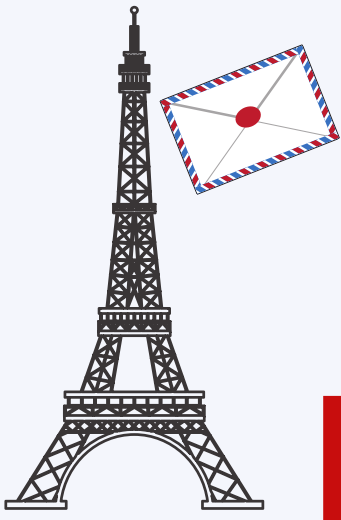

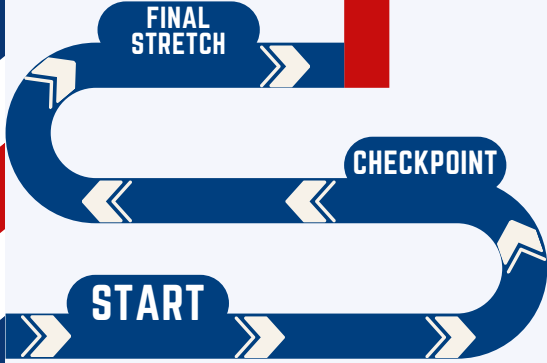


# FRENCH FOR TEENS AND TWEENS

- Grammar (articles, adjectives, pronouns, possessive adjectives, prepositions)

- Talk about morning and evening activities • Hours and time • Ask questions
- Places in a city • Ask for directions • Talk about locations
- Express likes and dislikes • Express opinions
- Order food and drinks • Monuments in Paris • French-speaking countries
- Reflexive verbs • School subjects • Ask and give opinions and reasons

- Talk about a person's schedule and timetable • Compose long text or letter
- Talk about after-school activities • More common verbs
- Tell french telephone numbers • Sports and games • Musical instruments
- Ask and talk about hobbies • Activities at the leisure center
- Activities on holidays • Talk about events in the past (past tense)
